All universities in Mongolia are already opened and the regular educational activities start.

The new laboratory at MUST is already equipped and the opening is next week.

Dissemination:

- Three collaborative papers for project dissemination were presented and published by Polito, TU-Sofia and NUM;
- The partners from MUST published a paper at 2020 IEEE Region 10 Symposium (TENSYP), 5-7 June 2020, Dhaka, Bangladesh and they won the best paper award.

Slavka Tzanova proposed to enrich the e-learning courses with life lecturing from European partners to Mongolian universities and all partners agreed on it.

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topics to be taught by the EU partners online and in a life session; to continue active dissemination of project results.
